


Color Theory: Part 1

Primary colors: Colors that are not created from any other combination of colors, Red, Yellow & Blue.
All colors can be created by mixing the Primary colors plus black and white.

Secondary colors: Created by mixing the Primary colors; green (yellow + blue), orange (yellow + red), and purple (red + blue).

Tertiary colors: The colors that can be mixed to be between the primary and secondary colors. For example, between red and orange, you would have redorange.



Complimentary colors: The colors that are located on opposite sides from each other on the color wheel. They are called complimentary because when two compliments are placed next to each other they enrich each other.
