### PROGRAM COVER CONTEST

The 2020 CTE Fall Conference Committee is seeking entries from middle and high school students for the conference program cover design.

#### OFFICIAL RULES FOR THE COVER CONTEST

- 1. Students currently enrolled in a Career Technical Education (CTE) graphics class are eligible to submit <u>ONE</u> entry. The maximum number of entries allowed is **ten (10) per teacher**.
- All entries must reflect the information in the top five (5) header lines of this announcement and, <u>in addition</u>, need to include 1) the <u>CTE Conference Logo</u>, which can be downloaded from the CTE Fall Conference website [cteconference.org], 2) the dates <u>November 18-20, 2020</u> and 3) location of the conference: <u>Omni Rancho Las Palmas</u>.
- 3. The maximum size of the submitted design is 8 1/2 x 11 inches. *The top three winners will be required to submit their work electronically and the first place winner may be requested to edit their work by the committee.*
- 4. Submissions must be computer developed and generated using only the listed colors.
  - a. Theme Colors: **PMS 19-4029 (Navy Peony)**, **PMS 19-1629 (Ruby Wine)**, **PMS 15-1225 (Sand)** Use the Pantone color converter to find CYMK numbers.
  - b. NOTE: Black may be used. Program will be printed on white stock.
- 5. The entry must be submitted on white paper-not mounted
- 6. All entries will be judged on:
  - a. Spelling (NOTE: Entries with misspellings will be disqualified).
  - b. Meeting all criteria of this contest
  - c. Creativity and the effective use of color
  - d. Craftsmanship, clarity and neatness
  - e. Ability to be effectively printed/reproduced (jpeg)
- 7. Entries need to be received by Wednesday, March 4, 2020, 4:00 pm., in the office of North Orange County ROP, 385 N. Muller Street, Anaheim, CA 92801. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- The winners will be selected by the conference committee and will receive: first place winner-\$500, second place \$350, and third place winner-\$150. In addition, up to three Honorable Mention winners will receive: \$50. The first, second and third place winners will be recognized at the conference and all winners' artwork will be displayed.
- 9. Winners will be contacted via email. An announcement of the winners will be posted on the cteconference.org website by April 2, 2020.
- 10. No artwork will be returned.
- 11. All submissions must be accompanied by the entry form **securely attached to the back of the artwork (staples, tape no paperclips)** containing all contact information, signature of the parent/legal guardian, and teacher. Signatures grant the conference committee the right to use winner's name, entry and photograph for publicity purposes.
- 12. Entrants accept and agree to these rules. The decision of the committee which shall be final.
- 13. Winning student agrees to make modifications to artwork requested by the conference committee in a timely manner.
