- The name of your career.
- A specific job description.
- Qualifications for that career.
- Expected skill set for that career.
- Expected technical knowledge for that career area.
- Necessary training and/or qualifications needed in order to work in that career.
- Expected entry level salary.
- Potential maximum salary.
- Geographic locations that are hiring for this career.
- Potential companies to work for.
- You must use Emphasis and include a grid at either 90°, 30°, 45°, or 60° and everything should align parallel and perpendicular to one another.
- You may use up to 4 colors (black, white, and 2 of your choice). Colors need to be appropriate for your career choice and to grab attention of the viewer in a positive manner.
