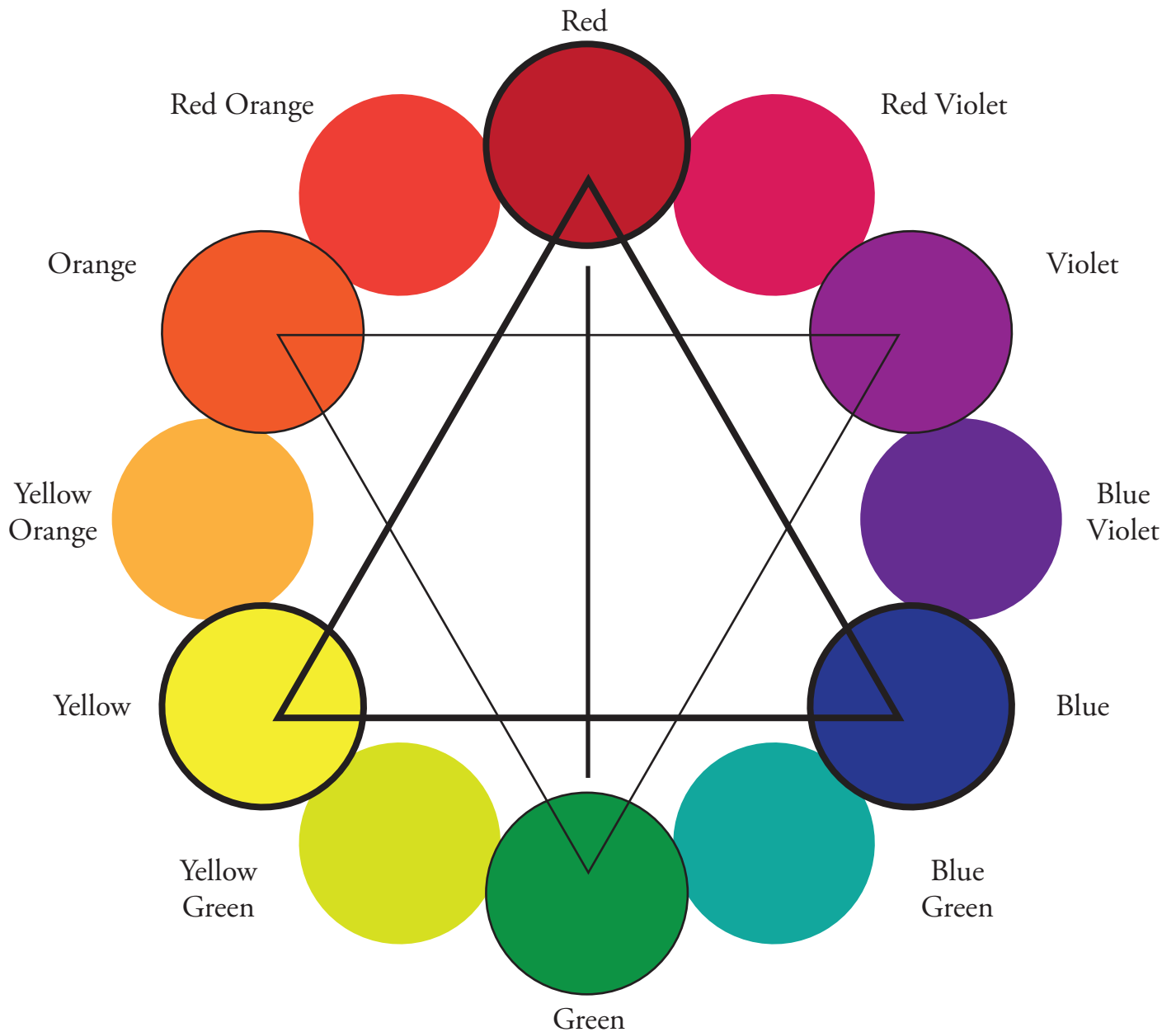

## COLOR TERMINOLOGY

**Primary Colors:** Colors at their basic essence; those colors that cannot be created by mixing others - *Red, Yellow, Blue.*

**Secondary Colors:** Those colors achieved by a mixture of two primaries- *Orange, Violet, Green.*

**Tertiary Colors:** Those colors achieved by a mixture of primary and secondary hues - *Red Orange, Red Violet, Yellow Orange, Yellow Green, Blue Green, Blue Violet.*

## Color Theory:

**Monochromatic:** Using variations of one color.



**Analogous Colors:** Those colors located close together on a color wheel. Complimentary



**Complementary Colors:** Those colors located opposite each other on a color wheel (Primary + Secondary or Tertiary + Tertiary) - *Red - Green, Yellow - Violet, Blue - Orange.*



**Split Complementary:** A variation of the complementary color scheme where one color in the complimentary color scheme is replaced the the two colors adjacent to it.



**Triadic:** Uses three colors that are evenly spaced around the color wheel.



**Tetradic:** Uses 4 colors evenly spaced around the color wheel.



*To vary your scheme try using shades, tints and tones as well as desaturating colors for creative and interesting variations.*
